In 1854, the American engineer Elisha Graves Otis invented a safety brake (11) Three years later he designed the first passenger lifts in the United States. Thanks to Otis, people no longer had to climb hundreds of stairs (12), and so buildings could be much taller. Thanks to Otis we have skyscrapers today! The telescope was invented in Holland in 1608. The Italian astronomer Galileo Galilei heard about this new invention in 1609 and soon he built his own telescope.
